

CURRICULUM VITAE OF PROF. DOTT. MED. LEONELLO MILANI, MD; PhD



Leonello Milani was born on 2nd June 1949 in Milan (Italy) where he graduated thus becoming M.D. (1974) with first class honours, with a degree thesis that has been entirely published (1975) on the “Cahiers de Neurologie”, Ed. Desfontaines in Toulon (France), where he specialized in Neurology in 1978.

He got various diplomas: in Acupuncture (1980), Homeopathic Medicine (1987), Manipulation Medicine (1989), Diplome at the International Association of Homotoxicology, Germany (1995), Diplome at the Italian

Academy of Biological Medicine (1998)].

He taught at the University of Milan (Italy), University of Calabria (Italy), University of Siena (Italy), Hospital Medical School of Naples (Italy), the Medical University of Montpellier (France), the Bouisson-Bertrand Institute of Nîmes (France), the Medical University of Cairo (Egypt), the University of Sevilla (Spain), the Integral Medicine Institute of Madrid (Spain), the Illinois Chiropractic Society (USA), the Lombard Medical School (Illinois, USA), the Loyola University – Chicago (USA).

From 1979 to 2000 he taught at the Centre of Natural and Physical Therapy Studies in Turin (Italy).

He has been: Vice-president of the Italian Centre of Medical Psychology Studies (1982-83-84), President of the Italian Society of Surgical Medical Laser Therapy (1987-88-89)], President of the Italian Society of Reflexology, Acupuncture and Auricular Therapy (1992-93-94)], General Secretary of the Italian Medical Association for the Teaching of Acupuncture and Reflexotherapies (1987-2000), Director of Studies of the Four-year School of Acupuncture and Complementary Techniques, formerly Italian Institute of Acupuncture (1988-2000).

Since 1994 he has been Vice-president of A.I.O.T. (Italian Medical Association of Homotoxicology), since 1998 he has been teaching at the School of Homeopathy, Homotoxicology and Integrated Medicines (I and III year). Accredited Tutor at the ODM (Italian Medical Association) in Rome (since 1999).

He has been Editor in Chief of the Review “Minerva Riflessoterapeutica”, Editor in Chief of the Review “Lasernews”.

At present (since 1997) he is Scientific Director of the Review “La Medicina Biologica” (Biological Medicine) and since 2004 of “Physiological Regulating Medicine”.

He took part in over 140 Scientific Congresses in Italy and abroad as a speaker and/or a Chairman; he wrote 8 books, 77 Articles on Italian and Foreign Scientific Reviews and 102 scientific-medical Articles published on Magazines and Newspapers. He wrote 4 Chapters of the Italian Medical Encyclopedia (Walk-Over) and of the Encyclopedia “Il Mio Bambino” [“My Child” (Walk-Over)].

In 30 years of teaching profession he has given more than 4000 hour lectures.

In addition to Seminars in Italy, he has been teaching in 47 Seminars abroad: in U.S.A., France, Spain, U.K., Russia, Norway, Ukraine, Israel and Turkey.

- Since 1992 he has been Knight of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem.

He is Professor *Honoris Causa* of the Advanced Institute of Health Studies in Rome, an Italian organization co-operating with the W.H.O. (2000).

- He got 3 Masters in the USA and 2 Masters in Italy.
